Women in sport in Asia

Overview

The importance of realizing a gender equal society through sport is a much discussed topic in recent times. The IOC and UN Women have established a partnership with the aim of creating a gender equal sporting culture as well as using sport for empowering girls and women and achieving a gender equal society. The government of Japan established a legacy project for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic games aiming to expand the value of sports to more than 10 million people in over 100 nations until 2020 under the name of Sport for Tomorrow. The Japanese government has also made a commitment with ASEAN states (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) to foster women and sport in the ASEAN region as one of the four priority areas of cooperation. This session will include the presentation from a high-level Japanese government official who will present the policy level commitment of the cooperation between ASEAN and Japan as well as presentations from experts from Thailand and Singapore about the women and sport movement in the region.
